Please refer to your RTI application dated 07.05.2019 which is forwarded by CPIO & Assistant Commissioner of Customs, RTI Cell (A&A) under the provision of Section 6(3) of the Right to Information Act' 2005 and received on 14.05.2019 on the above subject.

Under Section 3 of the RTI Act 2005, information can be given only to Indian citizen. The RTI application is silent about the citizenship. Hence, it is not possible to determine whether he is eligible to get the information as desired. As such, desired information cannot be provided.

However, if you are aggrieved with the information you may prefer an appeal against the same to Shri Rahul Mahato, Joint Commissioner of Customs, 1st Appellate Authority (A&A), Office of the Commissioner of Customs, Custom House, 15/1, Strand Road, Kolkata – 700001 within 30 (thirty) days from the date of receipt of this letter.
