
Sub: RTI application Registration No. CCUKL/R/2019/50011 dated 23/01/2019 - regarding.

This refers to your RTI application bearing the subject Registration no. and date relating to bill of entry no. 9743568 dated 22/01/2019.

As requested, the information sought in the subject application is hereby provided as below-

1. The bill of entry no. 9743568 dated 22/01/2019 has been granted out-of-charged on 05/02/2019 without requiring NOC from PQ authorities.
2. As per ITC-HS Schedule-1 Import policy, import of items **classifiable** under 96031000 are freely importable. This CTH covers finished products and not raw materials. Plant Quarantine department is Participating Government Agency (PGA) of Customs Department. Any consignment requiring NOC from any PGA is automatically routed to that agency through SWIFT (Single Window Interface for Facilitation of Trade). Hence, any consignment requiring PQ NOC will be automatically routed to them through SWIFT. Normally no manual interference is made for PQ NOC. This procedure has been adopted for referring or not referring any consignment for PQ NOC. In the instant case, the bill of entry was not routed to PQ authorities for NOC purpose through SWIFT and therefore, the same has been released without requiring NOC from PQ authorities.

If the applicant is not satisfied with the reply, he may prefer an appeal to the Appellate Authority, ADC, Amrendra Narayan within 30 days from the receipt of this Order under Section 19 of the RTI Act, 2015
