
Reference is invited to your RTI application bearing Registration No. "Nil" dated 23.07.2019 which was transferred to this Section by the Deputy Commissioner of Customs, A-1 (Port), Custom House, Kolkata vide letter F. No. S60(Misc)-150/2017-A(G)Pt.-1 dated 30/07/2019.

The desired information sought vide above application dated 23.07.2019 are as follows:-

- (i) As per the information retrieved from the EDI System, only two used vehicle were imported through Kolkata Port during last five years, vide Bills of Entry Nos. **5728357** dated **22.06.2016** "Toyota Rava Model No. DVA-ACA 36 W Chassis No. ACA36-5030573, Black, 2360 cc Gasoline Engine Power (Used Vehicle) Diplomatic Cargo" by Mr. Chang D. Tshering (Diplomatic Vehicle) & vide Bill of Entry No. **2593843** dated **25.07.2017** declared as 'Used Vehicle RHD, Hummer H3, Petrol 3400CC, color Black, Chassis No. ADMDN13E384430791, YOM: Feb-2008, Engine No. M84430791' by Mr. Jaspreet Singh Dandona.

- (ii) One. The consignment imported against Bill of Entry No. 2593843 dated 25.07.2017 was confiscated for violating various import policy norms, however the same was redeemed after imposing redemption fine and penalty in compliance of CESTAT Final Order No. FO/76831/2018 dated 08.10.2018 passed by the CESTAT, EZB, Kolkata under section 129B of the Customs Act, 1962 in Appeal No. C/75937/2018-DB in the matter of M/s Jaspreet Singh Dandona -Vs- Commissioner of Customs (Port), Kolkata.
- (iii) One. The consignment imported against Bill of Entry No. 2593843 dated 25.07.2017 was allowed to be redeemed subsequent to CESTAT Final Order Nos. FO/76831/2018 dated 08.10.2018 passed by the CESTAT, EZB, Kolkata under section 129B of the Customs Act, 1962 in Appeal No. C/75937/2018-DB in the matter of M/s Jaspreet Singh Dandona -Vs- Commissioner of Customs (Port), Kolkata.
- (iv) to (vi) Query pertains to Special Disposal Cell (Port) which has been requested to reply directly to the applicant.

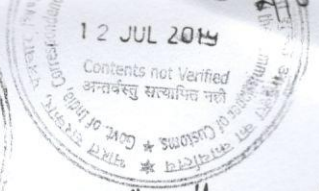

Sub: - Request to furnish Information as per the provisions of "Right to Information Act, 2005"

I may be furnished with the following information under Right to Information Act, 2005.

1. How many used vehicles were imported through Kolkota port for last 5 year.
2. How many vehicles were confiscated by Customs authority during last 5 year alleging violation of Import Policy.
3. Out of such confiscated vehicles, how many vehicles were allowed to redeem by the importer on payment of redemption fine and penalty.
4. Out of such confiscated vehicles, how many vehicles were disposed by auction after its confiscation.
5. Out of such confiscated vehicles, how many vehicles were disposed by auction after taking certificate by a testing agency confirming that the imported vehicle is in compliance with the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988, the vehicle confirm to the original homologation certificate and also certificate from Vehicles Research and Development Establishment or Automotive Research Association of India.
6. Out of such vehicles confiscated during last 10 years, how many vehicles are still lying with Customs without auction. If any such vehicles still lying with Customs, kindly give the reason for the delay in disposal of each vehicles, since such detention is against the direction issued by Revenue Board vide Notification No.7/1993-Cus dated 25.01.93.

I am paying an amount of Rs.10/- as postal order towards fee for above information/copies of the document. Further it is intimated that I am willing to pay additional cost if any for the above documents as and when your office intimate it.
