Subject: Implementation of Electronic Sealing (RFID-e-Sealing) for Containers under self-sealing procedure.

Attention of all exporters, trade and industry, Customs Brokers and others concerned is invited to Circular No.51/2017 –Customs dated 21.12.2017 on implementation of Electronic Sealing (RFID) of Containers by exporters under self-sealing procedure.

2. E-sealing is mandatory from 1st March, 2018 for all categories of exporters except those who are found ineligible for self-sealing facility.
3. Exporters of all categories of cargo allowed Direct Port Entry (DPE) previously are also required to operate under RFID e-sealing unless found ineligible for availing self-sealing facility as per CBEC Circular No.26/2017 dated 01.07.2017.
4. If the exporters are found ineligible for availing self-sealing facility, they will have to route their export consignment through CFS.
5. Exporters of Tea who are found ineligible for self sealing facility will however be allowed Direct Port Entry considering the delicate nature of cargo.
6. Public Notice Nos. 58/17 dated 06.10.17,72/17 dated 31.10.17,77/17 dated 14.11.17 and 83/17 dated 08.12.17 issued in this regard are to be referred.
7. Difficulties, if any, should be brought to the Notice of the undersigned.
