SUB:- Analysis of samples of imported Food Articles under prevention of Food Adulteration Act,1954 at Central Public Health & Drugs Laboratory, Kolkata and Export Inspection Agency, Kolkata- regarding:

It has been experienced that analysis report of samples of many imported items of food articles under Prevention of Food Adulteration Act 1954 is taking time and the reports are getting delayed, causing inconvenience to the importers/public as well as delay in assessment and clearance of imported goods.

Considering the difficulties the Food Safety and Standard Authority Of India, Ministry Of Health and Family Welfare(PFA) Division, New Delhi have been pleased to authorize more laboratories in Kolkata besides the CFL Kolkata for expeditious testing of the samples.

The following two laboratories are authorized to undertake analysis for all imported food articles which are imported through international borders/sea ports /Airports/ICD under the jurisdiction of CFL Kolkata. The analysis fees of Rs. 3000/- per sample shall be paid to the laboratories by the importers.

The CFL Kolkata will be the Appellate laboratory in the region as per the existing rules.

So it is brought to the notice of trade and industries to avail this facility.
